### Day 1

Depart via scheduled air service to Rome, Italy

### Day 2

**Rome**

Arrive in Rome

Meet your MCI Tour Manager, who will assist the group to the awaiting chartered motorcoach

Enjoy walking guided orientation tours of Rome's highlights - Spanish Steps, Piazza Navona, Piazza Venezia, Trevi Fountain, National Monument to Victor Emmanuel II, Monument to Garibaldi on Janiculum Hill (with a stunning overlook view of Rome)

Late afternoon hotel check-in

Evening Welcome Dinner and overnight

*Rome - Popes, Vandals, the Borgias and Napoleon, Garibaldi, Michelangelo and Mussolini and, of course, the ancient Romans themselves all have left their physical and spiritual mark on Rome, but though she keeps the glory of an ancient day about her, she remains a wellspring of creative energy; in short, she really is the Eternal City*

### Day 3

Morning guided walking tour of *Imperial Rome*, including entrance to the Roman Forum and Colosseum. Also visit the Pantheon, Baths of Caracalla, and Palatine Hill

Walking tour of *Religious Rome* includes Vatican City, the home of the Pope and the center of Roman Catholicism, as well as the Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel (featuring Michelangelo's Ceiling Frescos and The Last Judgment) and St. Peter's Basilica

Breakfast at the hotel, followed by check-out

Transfer to Florence

Afternoon guided orientation tour of Florence includes the Piazza della

*Concert Tours With Integrity*

Signoria, a lovely square in the heart of the city, towered by the lofty Palazzo Vecchio. Visit the Ponte Vecchio, the bridge across the Arno. See the Baptistery with Ghiberti's *Gates of Paradise*, the Campanile, and entrance to the Duomo and the Academia, the Academy of Fine Arts, to see Michelangelo's original *David* and other sculptures by the great master (using the whisper system)

**Day 6** **Florence / Cremona** **(B,D)**

Breakfast at the hotel, followed by check-out

Morning at leisure in Florence, followed by transfer to Cremona

Lunch, on own

A half-day guided tour of Cremona includes the Civic Museum, Duomo (Cathedral), Town Hall, and most importantly, entrance to Stradivarius museum – Museo del Violino. There are galleries devoted to the origins of the violin, violin construction, and Stradivari's workshop tools, molds and drawings

Evening dinner and overnight in Cremona

*An agricultural town known for its medieval appearance, Cremona rises from the slope above the north bank of the historic River Po. Antonio Stradivarius and other noted violin makers perfected their art in Cremona during the 17th and 18th centuries; a school still transmits their skills. Claudio Monteverdi whose Orfeo is considered to have laid the groundwork for modern opera in 1607, was born in Cremona*

**Day 7** **Busseto / Cremona** **(B,D)**

Breakfast at the hotel

Morning excursion to Busseto, which has ancient roots that date back to the 10<sup>th</sup> century. Visits include the Teatro Verdi Opera House, Verdi's birthplace, and Casa Barezzi (former home of Antonio Barezzi)

Lunch, on own

Afternoon free-time for shopping or additional sightseeing

**Day 8** **Cremona / Venice** **(B,D)**

Breakfast at the hotel, followed by check-out

Morning visit to the Cremona Luthier Shop

Lunch, on own

Afternoon transfer to Venice. Upon arrival, enjoy a guided walking orientation tour

Evening dinner and overnight

*Venice is eternally preoccupied with the contemplation of its own beauty. Founded on marshes, it rose to dominate the Adriatic and hold the gorgeous East in fee. At the height of her power in the 16th century, Venice was a wealthy city-republic glorying in feasts and pageants, reveling in the splendor of her painting, sculpture and architecture. Those days of glory are gone, but her art survives and the grace and refinement remain. A visit to Venice will fill your soul*



**Day 9**

**Venice**

**(B,D)**

Breakfast included at the hotel

Transfer to the main island of San Marco via public boat. A morning walking tour includes St. Mark's Square, with entrance to the incredibly rich Basilica of St. Mark and the Doge's Palace where the powerful and prosperous dukes of Venice ruled their far-flung empire at its height during the 15th century

Lunch, on own

Afternoon time at leisure in Venice

Evening Farewell Dinner and overnight

**Day 10**

**Depart for home**

**(B)**

Breakfast at the hotel, followed by check-out

Transfer to the Venice Airport for return flight home
